Reported Crime

The following information is extracted from the Cambridgeshire Police website and is the crime reported by the police www.police.uk in July 2015 in The Hemingfords.

Hemingford Abbots (0)

Hemingford Grey (13)

Burglary (4): 1 on or near Church Street, 1 on or near Margetts, 1 on or near Sadlers Way, and 1 on or near Stepping Stones.

Anti-social behaviour (2): 1 on or near Maytrees, and 1 on or near Oakfields.

Violence (3): 2 on or near Weir Close and 1 on or near The Brambles.

Vehicle Crime (3): 2 on or near the A1096 and 1 on or near Elizabeth Court.

Other Crime (1): 1 on or near Elizabeth Court.

One of our village residents living close to the playing field has recently reported to me seeing 3 men behaving rather suspiciously near the childrens' playing area. When they realised they'd been seen they left the field and drove off in a white van.

The following is a slightly modified version of an e-mail I received from the NHW coordinator for Hemingford Grey.

On Tuesday 8th Sept at 9.45 a white van was seen driving down Weir Close with 2 white males in. The vehicle parked at the bottom of the close and the driver got out and visited 3 houses.

At the first he asked if they need any help with hedge cutting and handed over a leaflet.

At the second he asked if they needed help with hedge cutting and at the third house he asked about a dismantled rotten shed on the front drive.

He then got in the van without calling on anybody else and drove to the top of Weir Close and got out of the van and looked back before driving off.

The registration number of the van is BK10 FLP.
