Reported Crime

The following information is extracted from the Cambridgeshire Police website and is the crime reported by the police www.police.uk in August 2015 in The Hemingfords.

Hemingford Abbots (0)

Hemingford Grey (16)

Burglary (4): 1 on or near Playing field, 1 on or near Margetts, 1 on or near Oakfields, and 1 on or near Stepping Stones.

Anti-social behaviour (6): 3 on or near Maytrees, 1 on or near Burlington Way, 1 on or near The Rampleys, and 1 on or near Oakfields.

Criminal Damage (4): 1 on or near Priors Road, 1 on or near St Ives Road, 1 on or near Maytrees, and 1 on or near The Brambles.

Vehicle Crime (1): 1 on or near St Ives Road.

Other Theft (1): 1 on or near Lea Road.

This will be my last monthly report for the parish magazine as I have now resigned from NHW after doing it since 1999. It's not yet known who will replace me but I'm sure that someone will step forward.

The village is split into 17 small areas for NHW and each area has a local NHW coordinator. Some of these posts are vacant and volunteers are needed. The exact breakdown of the village and the names of the coordinators can be seen on the village website.

The Parish Council fully support NHW and fund any expenditure and so all villagers are "members" of the scheme. This differs from other localities where a membership fee is required.
