

BOATING ON RIVER GREAT OUSE

From 29th March Boating is allowed on River Great Ouse however on open boats the Rule of 6 from no more than two households applies in the open. Anyone in a closed cabin boat must be from the same household. No one is allowed to stay overnight on any boat unless it is their main residence. Observe Social distancing at all times

Further easing of these regulations is planned from April 12th and we will update this guidance at that time

From 2nd - 4th April there will be restrictions and closures on River Great Ouse Downstream of Ely to Littleport as a result of the Cambridge Oxford University Boat Race being relocated for this year from River Thames between Mortlake and Putney. There are no provisions for spectators and everyone who wishes to do so should follow BBC coverage on both Radio and TV
